Hello Praying Friends,

We continue to value your prayers realising that delays are only going to be overcome with God's intervention. We pray God will bless you as you are such a blessing to us.

South Africa Masiphumelele internet radio – Are preparing their studio. Pray for this station to be on air very soon. Pray that the opportunity to provide supervised homework clubs as means of helping local kids achieve academically but also using the opportunity to bring, possibly unchurched kids, into church to hear the gospel via these broadcasts. This is in the planning stage so pray God will reveal His plans and open doors as He sees fit.

Africa by Radio meetings

Africa by Radio of which we function as the current Secretariat meet in Benin from 18-21 March, 2014. PTL that registration has been good but pray that many local pastors and missionaries in particular will respond to a radio advert invitation that is being aired in the city and come along to the meetings to hear how media, particularly new media can assist them in evangelistic outreaches, discipleship and church planting. It also works in reverse, media can learn from them. Pray for the trainers offering a 2 day course on Writing for Hearers that God will use the training to increase the capacity to use media to share the Gospel. Pray for Gods protection and provision on all involved plus attendees, including their families and ministries. When you're writing a newsletter, write it so that someone who has never heard of your company can understand what you're offering as quickly as possible. Stay away from using jargon, acronyms, or complicated terms.

Madagascar

Another property may be available to the Maroantsetra radio work. Please pray for wisdom not to get sidetracked and for the license to be signed soon, pray that God will overcome all delays in getting this station on air. Pray for good health for one of the organisers(he has had some serious health challenges) and pray for favour with the authorities for all who work on the project. Pray for God to soften hearts in the community in preparation for them hearing the Gospel.

Technical Assistance

We have identified the need for Technical assistance both in the RAN office and as a means of assisting stations across Africa who do not have easy access to technicians. Please pray with us and others who are considering helping us, as we explore ways of meeting this need.

Continue to pray for opportunities in Mali, Zambia and Central African Republic - particularly pray for peace there. Pray for open doors in Zimbabwe.
